APM/18/05 Chairman's Report	<p>The chair welcomed everyone and thanked them for coming to the annual meeting especially the members of the public and Peter Cooper the NHS First Responder.</p> <p>The chair welcomed Sheena Bexson as a new Councillor based in Ivinghoe Aston. This year we have entered the Bucks Best Kept Village and urged people to keep the area tidy especially Station Road. The parish council put new fitness equipment on Ivinghoe Lawn and two rides in Ivinghoe Aston, we have purchased a new Ivinghoe flag. A new noticeboard will be placed by Brookmead and the old one will be refurbished and moved to IA. Two defibrillators have been purchased the one in Ivinghoe was donated by the WI. AVDC New Homes Bonus has been granted to pay for new railings on Ivinghoe Lawn, the council keeps failing inspections due to the gates not closing and the railings being old and damaged. The chairman thanked the clerk for securing the funding. Bucks County Councillor Wight has paid for an outside table tennis table which will be installed later in the year.</p> <p>Ivinghoe will have a tree expert survey the trees. The council would like to make more parking in Station Road and is getting quotes for this.</p> <p>Speedwatch is one year old today so far there have been 1,500 vehicles speeding through the village which have been sent to TVP. The chairman thanked all the volunteers who assist the council, the Town Hall committee, Peter Snowden for maintaining the allotments, Brian Rogers for doing lots of odd-jobs. The Neighbourhood Plan team who have worked very hard and nearly finished the plan.</p> <p>The chairman thanked PCSO Jackie Dodson for attending and thanked AVDC District Councillor Peter Cooper for running some defibrillator training.</p>
